

**Kohler Public Schools**  
**Open Enrollment Seats**  
**2023-2024**

Kohler Public School District sets the open enrollment seat availability based on current enrollment and projections. The 2023-2024 seat availability for open enrollment is determined by the district class size and staffing guidelines established by the Board.

Applications for students with special needs are accepted based on space availability using the Department of Public Instruction's Statewide Factor Caseload Formula for special education teacher's caseloads. The number of factors available in the District are as follows: 0 factors in the elementary school, 0 factors in the middle school, and 0 factors in the high school. The DPI caseload recommendations were used to determine the number of seats in Speech and Language and Occupational Therapy. The number of open seats in the Speech and Language program is 0 and the number of open seats in Occupational Therapy program is 1. All contracted services are closed (e.g., PT, VI, HI, O & M, and audiology).

The district will make open enrollment seats available up to an amount to maintain a cushion percentage reserved for resident growth. The cushion reserved for resident growth (measured in seats) is calculated by multiplying the cushion percentage times the maximum seats per section. The cushion percentages are as follows:

- At least a 7% cushion in the elementary school
- At least a 5% cushion in the middle school
- At least a 5% cushion in the high school

The projected enrollment includes resident students and current students under open enrollment. The elementary school sections are based on administrative guidelines 2312 and current staffing. The middle school and high school sections are based on the number of English classes and current staffing.
