

Highlights: Big East Conference Champions! WIAA Regional & Sectional Champions STATE qualifier - Lost in semi-final to Sturgeon Bay 0-1. The 2017 Kohler High School Boys Soccer season was one of the best in the program's history. We compiled an undefeated 22-0-1 overall record, and 11-0-0 in conference play. We won 5 trophies throughout the season as champions of the Sheboygan South Redwing Invitational, Green Bay East Invitation, Big East Conference, WIAA Regional, and WIAA Sectional. Seven players were awarded All Conference honors and Captain Ben Herold was named Big East Conference Player of the Year and earned All-State honors. Equally important, we continued to build for the future by fielding a highly competitive JV team in a robust 20 game schedule. Playing against many larger schools and multiple Varsity teams the JV team produced a solid 10-7-3 record.

SEASON SUMMARY

Swimming is a little unusual in that we do not compete head to head against most teams. We typically compete in triangulars or invites, so there is not a conference standings or conference record.

Highlights: KLF had a great season. Our numbers allowed us to compete at both the Varsity and Junior Varsity level. We participated in 1 non-conference meet, 6 Invitationals and 4 Conference meets. We won our non-conference home meet against Port Washington. Of our Conference triangular meets we lost only to Plymouth by 9 points, Beating Berlin, Chilton, Kiel and Two Rivers. At Invitationals we finished; 4/9, 6/7, 6/10, 8/9 and 13/18. The season ended with taking second at sectionals. Plymouth was able to pull out the win with the last events beating us by 2 points. Sectionals placed us 5^{th} out of 13 teams and qualifying 1 swimmer for state. Kara Friske quantified 14^{th} in the 100 Backstroke and improved to 13^{th} place after her swim to end our season. Elizabeth Burhholz will be hired next year to take over the program with Jessica Ott serving as the assistant.




