

What is Bomber Pride? Why are we doing it?



- Bomber Pride is Kohler's version of Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS)
- PBIS is a state initiative to promote positive behaviors resulting in less time spent on behavior management and more time on academics.
- PBIS schools across Wisconsin have created a more positive environment for students and staff by establishing clear expectations for their students and taking active steps in teaching, modeling and reinforcing appropriate behaviors school wide.

The Bomber Pride Process

- 1. **Define:** clear and consistent definitions of behavior expectations
- 2. **Teach:** direct teaching of behavior expectations
- 3. Remind: daily reminders, supervision & rewards
- 4. **Celebrate:** consistent acknowledgement of the expected behaviors
- 5. Correct: consistent correction of the problem behaviors

Timeline

Elementary School

(September to June)

- Full scale implementation
 - September focus on hallway & cafeteria behavior
- Data driven focus on behaviors

Middle/High School

(September to January)

- Focus on hallway & cafeteria behavior
- Data analysis from the PBIS team
- Sharing of data with school
- PBIS team meeting for implementation

(January to June)

- Full scale implementation
- Data driven focus on behaviors

Bomber Behavior Matrix

The Bomber Behavior Matrix describes behavior expectations throughout the Kohler School District.

Students will be taught and rewarded for these behaviors throughout the school year.

Classroom Behavior Matrix

Each teacher has also developed their own classroom behavior matrix describing their classroom expectations.

Both schoolwide and classroom matrices are posted in each classroom as a visual reminder of expectations.

Acknowledgement System

Positive student behavior that meets and exceeds expectations will be acknowledged.

How will students be acknowledged?

- Student will be rewarded with a Bomber Buck
- Staff member will provide praise and verbal recognition indicating why the Bomber Buck was received

Acknowledgement System

Elementary School

- Bomber Bucks will be turned into classroom buckets.
- Once a week, each classroom bucket will be combined into grade level buckets, and a student will be drawn from each grade level bucket and rewarded.
- There will also be a monthly assembly including acknowledgements and the teaching of the next focus behavior.
- All Bomber Bucks will be combined in a large container to work towards a school-wide reward celebration that will be received once the school-wide goal has been reached.

Acknowledgement System

Middle/High School

- Prizes will be displayed in a case outside the library.
- Students can place their Bomber Bucks in the bucket for the prize they are interested in.
- A Bomber Buck will be selected from each bucket every two weeks.

Possible Prizes

- iTunes gift cards
- Bomber wear
- Movie passes
- Free homework passes
- First in lunch line for a week
- Craft kits
- Stuffed Animals
- Snack & beverage packages
- And many more...
